Malabar Milk Union is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme Namely National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD), as per the operational guidelines issued by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying.

Govt. of India had conveyed the Administrative Approval for implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (NPDD) with a total Project outlay of **Rs. 997.60 Lakh** with a GOI share of **693.23 Lakh** & EIA share of **304.37 Lakh** to MRCMPU for Palakkad, Malappuram, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Kannur & Kasaragod Districts for the period 2023-25.

As per the operational guidelines, the implementing agency has to engage an external agency for the final evaluation of the scheme to examine the achievements and impact of the schemes implemented.

NPDD scheme support includes Milk Chilling Facilities, Establishment of Laboratories, Accreditation and Certification of BMCs, Information and Communication Technology Networking, Training, Awareness Generation, and Planning and Monitoring.

As envisaged in the scheme, the MRCMPU Ltd wishes to conduct a Final Evaluation of the NPDD VIII (NPDD_KL_14J).

The study team may include specialists from different areas like Dairy Technology, Marketing, Engineering and Dairy Extension as far as possible.

The major objectives of the scheme are: -

- Monitor the quality of Milk Procured
- FSMS Certification and Upgrading of all Dairy Plants and selected DCS
- Capacity Building through Training and Awareness Programme
- Strengthening the Laboratory Infrastructure & equipment for more efficient testing and traceability.

Scope of the Work

1. Assessment is to be done on

1.1. Review the physical and financial targets and achievements (Head-wise)

1.2. Note the deviations from the project outlay and explain the reasons for the deviation.

- 1.3. Physical evaluation of assets created in the schemes like Milk Chilling facilities, Establishment of Laboratories, Information & Communication Technology Networking, Manpower Development, and Planning & Monitoring on a random basis.
- 1.4. Provide a chapter on the benefits obtained by milk producers by the implementation of NPDD.
- 1.5. Provide information on how the NPDD implementation helped to strengthen microfinancing among the rural farmer community.
- 1.6. Provide information regarding the extent of digitalisation in payments with respect to the implementation of the Project
- 1.7. Include the details about the Benefits to the Milk Union, like an increase in Procurement, Processing, and Marketing facilities.

4. Reports & Time frame

Ten copies of the report along with soft copy shall be submitted. The report shall contain overall study method adopted, basis of sample selection and the area selected. The report shall contain detailed findings on each component and an Executive Summary

5. Time Frame

The assignment shall be completed within a time frame of **3 months** from the date of the Award of Work.

6. Eligibility Criteria for the Bidding Party

6.1. Work experience in a Managerial Position in a Food Industry is compulsory.

The consultancy/agency should preferably have the support of the Dairy Technologist/Engineer with Dairy/Food industrial experience in the field of Quality Control and/or Production Section/or Projects/Engineering Section working full time or part-time or on a need basis.

7. Tender Document

7.1. Earnest Money Deposit: The offer should be accompanied by an EMD of Rs. 5,000.00 (Rupees Five Thousand only).

7.2. The Tender form shall be submitted in separate Covers viz. Technical Bid & Financial Bid.

7.3. The Technical Bid shall contain profiles of experts, suggested methodology, the composition of study team, time frame, terms and conditions and the cost involved.

7.4. The Financial Bid shall contain the cost of assessment for the entire Union to meet the project guidelines.

7.5. The Tender Evaluation Committee shall scrutinise the Technical Bid to find among the bidders having Technical Eligibility.

8. Evaluation & Selection Process

The finalisation of the consultant is based on the QCBS method to identify the parties who ensure detailed scientific and effective evaluation of the project to highlight the details of benefits to the farmers as well as to suggest the improvements needed in the project execution.

The consultancy service will be awarded to the firm that has achieved the highest score in the QCBS evaluation.

Proposal with the lowest amount may be given a financial score out of 100 (Hundred), and other proposals given financial scores that are inversely proportional to their prices with respect to the lowest offer.

Similarly, the proposal with the highest Technical Marks (as allotted by the evaluation committee) shall be given a score out of 100 (Hundred), and other proposals shall be given technical scores that are proportional to their marks with respect to the highest Technical Marks. The total score, both Technical and Financial, shall be obtained by weighing the quality and cost scores and adding them up. On the basis of the combined weighted score for quality and cost, the consultant shall be ranked in terms of the total score obtained.

The proposal obtaining the highest total combined score in evaluation of quality and cost will be ranked as H-1, followed by the proposals securing lesser marks as H-2, H-3 etc. The proposal securing the highest combined marks and ranked H-1 will be invited for negotiations, if required and shall be recommended for award of contract. In the event two or more bids have the same score in final ranking, the bid with highest technical score will be H-1. In such a case, an Evaluated Bid Score (B) will be calculated for each responsive Bid using the following formula, which permits a comprehensive assessment of the Bid price and the Technical merits of each Bid:

$$B = \frac{C_{low}}{C} X + \frac{T}{T_{high}} (1 - X)$$

where,

C = Evaluated Bid Price

C_{low} = the lowest of all Evaluated Bid Prices among responsive Bids

T = the total Technical Score awarded to the Bid

T_{high} = the Technical Score achieved by the Bid that was scored best among all responsive Bids

X = Weightage for the Price - 0.3

- **20%** of the amount will be released in due course of study as per the request from the consultant and the rest **80%** after the satisfactory completion and submission of reports of the work.
- Eligibility Criteria for the Bidding Party: Proof has to be produced along with the tender.
- The offer should be accompanied by an EMD and Tender fee as mentioned in the tender and the offers without EMD will be summarily rejected.
- The EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be released only upon finalization of the Consultancy/agency. The EMD of the successful bidder will be adjusted as part of the security sum of the Consultancy.

- The offer will be evaluated by the Union and the work will be awarded if the offer is found acceptable.
